		<p>Sudesh Amman shortly before he ran out of the store.</p> <p><b>Timothy Hudson</b> – car driver who saw the confrontation outside Boots.</p> <p><i>Jenny Munday – pedestrian who saw shots being fired.</i></p> <p><b>Slawomir Kudla</b> – local resident who, from his home, saw the confrontation between Sudesh Amman and armed officers.</p> <p><b>Omolara Ochei</b> – local resident who, from her home, saw Sudesh Amman running and then saw officers fire on him.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Evidence concerning assessment of the situation</u></b></p> <p><b>Superintendent Ross McKibbin</b> – MPS officer to give evidence concerning how officers were trained to respond to situations such as those they faced.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Experts</u></b></p> <p><b>Dr Ashley Fegan-Earl</b> – forensic pathologist who carried out the post-mortem examination upon Sudesh Amman.</p> <p><i>Fiona Ritchie – Ballistics expert who undertook ballistics analysis at the scene.</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Concluding evidence</u></b></p> <p><b>DCI Luke Williams</b> - evidence to clarify points raised by previous evidence and/or to address any remaining points not covered by previous evidence.</p>
